## Dropping off and collecting your child from school

As a school we are responsible for the welfare of your children and therefore have to consider what we believe is the best practice in ensuring the safety of our pupils at the end of the school day.

Our policy is that all parents must complete a password form for every child that attends George Carey School and that the password form must have the names and contact numbers of all the people you wish to collect your child/ren. Without this information we will not release the child/ren. Pupils in Nursery, Reception, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 must be collected by a known responsible adult or sibling over the age of 14 years old.

Pupils in Years 5 and 6 may request walk home alone permission by reading and completing a walk home agreement letter. This will then be reviewed by Mr Harrison. **The rules for 'walk home consent' include arrangements for walking to school at the start of the day as well.**

Permission to walk to and from school will be given considering the confidence and maturity of the child as well as the distance they live from school and the child's ability to consider their own safety.

## Hérons visit to The Museum of London

The children were able to explore the Beasts of London exhibit where they learned about the roles animals have played from the Roman era, through Medieval times right up to the present day.
