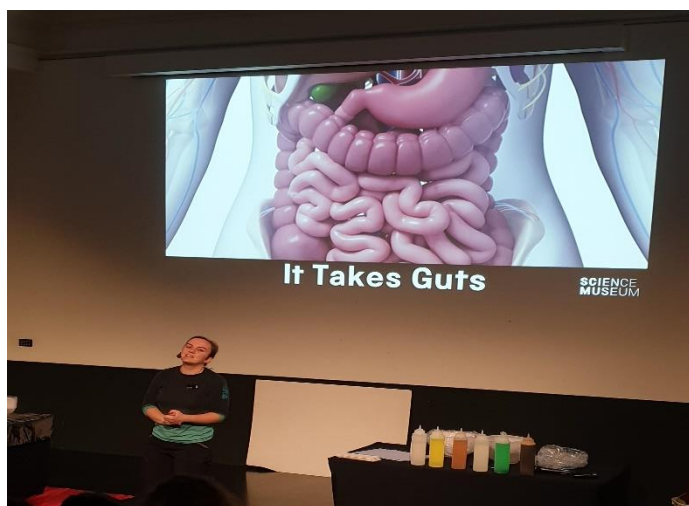
Reception Classes Virtual Reality Workshop
