Do you have a toothy grin or a winning smile? Take dental impressions and test the effects of sugary substances on your pearly whites! Follow a tasty morsel as it makes its way through your digestive system, helped by some mouth-watering saliva! Mmmmm! And don't forget the importance of good hygiene- at both ends!

Maths: The children will continue to learn addition and subtraction skills and will also be learning multiplication and division methods; they will be focussing on division with remainders. Children will be working on multiplying 3 digit numbers with numbers up to 10. They will work on long division where they will be working on dividing 3 digit numbers.

Art & Design: The children will design t-shirts showing the digestive system and practice drawing from memory. They will also look at how food labels are designed

Homework: The children will be given a homework grid with a range of cross-curricular activities for your children to complete at home. These activities will include mathematical tasks, writing tasks, scientific experiments, research activities and art and design activities.

English: The children will be writing fact files about teeth as well as journey fantasy narratives and some very silly poetry.

Music: Children will be making up their own song about the digestive system.

Science: We will be investigating how toothpaste protects our teeth. We will be carrying out investigations by predicting, measuring and observing. We will also be looking detail at the digestive system and conducting an experiment to find out what effect saliva has on breaking down food. The children will also use egg shells to discover the effects of sugary drinks on our teeth.

Physical development:

In our PE lessons we will focus on improving key skills: hand to eye coordination, footwork and using all of the body to achieve success. All of these skills will be learnt in a Covid safe way.

Computing: The children will be focusing on basic computing skills such as Word, Publisher and PowerPoint, as well as staying safe when searching for things online.

Religious Education:

We will be looking at the part of the bible that relates to incarnation and the birth of Jesus. Children will also learn about the Christian belief of the Holy Trinity.
