



All aboard the time machine! We are going back- way back to the Ancient Egyptian times where Gods were worshipped- Good and Bad. Mummies were kept hidden in tombs and special codes adorned coffins, walls and tombs. Taking a walk through the ancient land of Egypt we will discover so much more than pyramids.

Pharaohs

Maths: Following Maths No Problem we will learn about place value; reading, writing, comparing, ordering and rounding numbers. Additionally we will be challenged to improve our reasoning skills. You can do it year 5!

Art/Design and Technology: Pupils will become designers and create their very own Canopic Jars- What is a Canopic jar- well you will have to wait and find out!

All Pharaohs need jewels right? So we will be designing our very own jewellery and decorative garments to adorn our Pharaohs or Gods.

Physical development: The pupils will develop their invasion game skills through learning to move with a ball or Frisbee, catch a ball whilst moving, team work and cooperation, and outwitting an opponent. Also through dance we will 'Walk like an Egyptian' looking at developing motifs and sequences using inspiration from the images of the inside of tombs.

Computing: All about Safety online!

Children will learn about how to research and use the internet safely. Pupils will also be word processing some of their writing about Pharaohs.

Please ensure that you have parental controls on your devices at home to keep children safe.

RE: During this half term children will learn about Harvest, specifically God's promise and covenant. How do we use the earth's resources? We will also reflect on themes of selfishness and greed, amongst others. Through our topic learning we will also look at the importance of having a God and how people choose to worship.

English: We will be writing fact files about Egyptian Gods which will cement our topic learning on Gods. Writing chronological reports will allow the pupils to understand the historical events of discovering the Rosetta Stone. Our class novel is The Chocolate Cipher which will use as a stimulus to write our very own mystery story... Year 5 sleuths!

Science: Love to investigate! We certainly will! Have you ever wondered why milk goes off? The children will investigate what happens to milk when it is left. How did Cleopatra store her milk? We will learn to plan an investigation, predict the result then carry it out. Looking at our results the pupils will write conclusions as to what happened and why.

History: Pupils will discover all about Ancient Egypt. They will learn about Egyptian Gods and Goddesses and how important they were to the people. Children will explore the process of mummification and discover all about the way Egyptians thought about death and the afterlife. Pupils will also learn about the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun and much more....
