



## Year 3

*It's time to take a walk on the wild side! Learn about creepy crocs and amazing alligators. The deadly assassin bug and the vicious Venus Fly Trap. Use what you learn to create your own predator: cross your mum with a falcon or your teacher with a great white shark!*

**Maths:** The children will be learning about numbers to 1000, place value, addition and subtraction. We will be using the column method and renaming.

**English:** The children will be writing information leaflets about predators, persuasive writing and dilemma stories.

**Computing:** The children will be looking at internet safety and using the internet to research various predators. They will use Purple Mash to create electronic leaflets.

**Physical development:** In our PE lessons the children will focus on athletic skills such as sprinting, jumping for height and distance, and under arm throwing.

**Geography:** The children will locate continents and countries around the world. They will look at where alligators, crocodiles and a range of predators live and locate them on maps.

**RE:** In RE children will be learning about the Christian creation story and what Christians believe about God and Creation. They will also explore how we can look after creations.

**Spanish:** We will be learning some basic phrases in Spanish, including greetings, counting and recognising numbers up to 20. The children will be having basic conversations, learning to ask how somebody is and how to reply.

**Science:** The children investigate predators, their prey and will create food chains. Children will group animals based upon what they eat and discuss what would happen if part of the food chain collapsed.

**Art & Design:** Children will be designing and making their own 3D predator as part of a homework project / competition. Completed projects should be photographed and returned via the Class Dojo by 21<sup>st</sup> October. There will be a prize for the winner!
