Maths:

They will be continuing to develop and apply their skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

They will be focussing on deepening their mathematical understanding of familiar concepts and using bar models to represent their thinking.

The children will be taking part in code breaking and problem solving lessons as an opportunity to apply all they have learnt over the year.

Physical development:

Dance – Children will learn an underwater themed dance and prepare for sports day.

Computing:

We will be creating PowerPoint presentations to present our findings in topic.

Art & Design:

The children will be looking at famous paintings of the sea, coast, harbours and seaside. We will be comparing pictures of stormy, violent seas with calm, tranquil scenes. We will be describing the mood and movement of the sea in the painting.



Science: Growing plants

We will be looking at different animal habitats, and why they are best suited for the different animals. They will be sorting and classifying things found at the beach into different groups.

English:

In literacy we are looking at descriptive language and will be focussing on writing post cards.

The children will be learning some classic riddles and tongue twisters and trying to say them without getting tangled up!
