Summary of the impact of the Pupil Premium funding:-

- The progress of all cohorts of children entitled to Pupil Premium spending across the school has been greater than expectations (other than Y6 and Y3 writing and Y1 reading where the progress was approximately in line with expectations). Progress was particularly strong in terms of Y6 reading and maths, Y4 reading and writing and Y2 reading and maths.
- There is very little difference between the overall attainment of Pupil Premium cohorts and their Non Pupil Premium peers overall and attainment gaps overall are small. An exception to this is Year 6 (2017) where there were a number of children with additional needs who were entitled to Pupil Premium funding whose outcomes were lower than average. In some year groups overall cohorts of children entitled to Pupil Premium funding have caught up with and even out-performed their Non Pupil Premium peers (notably in Years 3, 4 and 5).
- In Year 2, although the achievement gap still exists, the cohort of children entitled to Pupil Premium Funding narrowed significantly, with children making accelerated progress compared to their Non Pupil Premium peers.

We feel that the Pupil Premium funding, together with the additional resources that this brings to the school, have been highly effective at closing and eradicating achievement gaps between disadvantaged children and their peers at George Carey Church of England Primary School.
